District Grants for 2020-21 are concluded! 37 projects, both single and multi-club, were funded for a total of \$104,182.69. Combining grant and club funds, these projects total \$214,306.28 of positive impact in our communities!

Doing Good in the World Globally

On May 10, we received a note from President Holger and Trustee Chair Ravi asking us all to dig deep to help India and other countries who are in a horrifying wave of COVID-19 cases and a staggering death toll.

With approval from the grants steering committee, on May 24, we authorized \$25,000 in unallocated District Designated Funds (DDF) to join a Global Grant responding to COVID-19 needs in Mysore India, D3181. The grant will establish an Oxygen bank providing oxygen support systems and other supplies to be used at home then returned to the bank to be provided to another patient. In addition to relieving overwhelmed hospitals, the grant is expected to benefit more than 2500 people.



We additionally have authorized requested DDF for two other Global Grants with one more in the pipeline, along with potentially two Global Scholarships. We expect to use our remaining unallocated DDF to support both PolioPlus and our Peace Fellowships.
