### Award Process

- Each Category identifies the number of items to be completed to receive an award for that category.
- Each question is equal in value. Once submitted, the total number of completed items will be compiled. One (1) point will be given for each completed task.
- RALLYE Award levels for the 2020-21 Rotary year are Bronze, Silver, Gold.
- A Club of Excellence will be chosen for Small, Medium, and Large clubs based on accomplishments.
- One overall Club of the Year will also be selected.
- Each Club is also asked to submit a short video or slide show (1 minute!) on what you consider your Club’s “favorite” project of the year. This is voluntary but encouraged, so we can share at RALLYE!
- As always, Clubs need to review each question carefully to determine its completed status. When answering questions, please use the **4-Way Test** as you determine completion or not.
- This form is a fillable PDF. Mark off the line items your club has completed successfully, then SAVE AS on your computer. Completed forms will be due to the **Awards Committee by 4/7/21** (<mailto:D5190awards@gmail.com>); however, you can certainly use this as a planning tool, too, to identify what your club will be focusing on during the year.
- RALLYE Awards will be announced and awarded at RALLYE 2021, April 30-May 2, 2021, at Harrah’s Lake Tahoe.

- The President Elect (President for 2021-22) attended PETS, PrePETS 2021, and registered for RALLYE 2021
- At least 3 members of the Club register for RALLYE 2021
- Create a leader development or mentorship program within your Club to learn leadership roles and responsibilities
- Review and update the Club's structures and processes to document, streamline, and enhance your members' Rotary experience
- Focus a weekly Club meeting program on leadership

### Integrity

**TOTAL Tasks needed for Award:**

**Bronze = 5, Silver =7, Gold = 8**

- Share the 4-Way Test in some way at **every** Club Meeting
- Focus one of your weekly Club meeting programs on the 4-Way Test and share it with the News Media about what it means in your community
- Focus a weekly Club meeting program on Ethics
- Hold a community Ethics Awareness event
- Develop an ongoing project to help build and promote good character in our youth
- Use character as one of the criteria when selecting students for scholarships (scholastic and/or trade)
- Utilize the correct Rotary branding on social media, marketing materials, and community signage
- Update your club website and social media at least monthly

- Complete at least 1 project in each Avenue of Service: Club, Youth, Vocation, Community, International
- Participate in a multi-club project or event
- Sponsor or participate in a Rotary grant-funded project: either a District or Global Grant
- Participate in a **multi-club** District grant-funded project
- Present a Club Member and/or community member(s) with a service award and recognition
- Sponsor one or more Rotary Youth programs such as RYLA, REGL, RYE, etc.
- Involve youth groups and/or non-Rotarians in community projects and/or fundraisers
- Record into Rotary Club Central the volunteer hours spent for each project
- Present a Club Member with the new Heart of Service Award for their number of volunteer hours
- Complete a Community Needs Assessment to evaluate the need in your local community
- Qualify as a 100% Every Rotarian Every Year Club: (EREY: minimum \$25/member donation to The Rotary Foundation Annual Fund with a club average of \$100+)
- Achieve an average contribution to the Polio Plus Fund (End Polio Now) of at least \$25/Member

**Bronze = 5, Silver = 7, Gold = 9**

- Induct a Member with a new classification
- Induct a Member who is under 40 years old
- Induct a member from an under-represented demographic group into your Club
- Record the birth year of all members into ClubRunner
- Provide trade-school scholarships
- Hold a community event that highlights and honors the diversity in your community
- Collaborate with other organizations or groups to complete a project
- Hold a Club Assembly to explore flexible membership and dues ideas
- Invite speakers from diverse or unique backgrounds and/or with diverse perspectives to speak at your Club
